### (A) Strategic Plan Revisions

The Strategic Plan was adopted in July 2007. It is revised every five years. The next Plan will be adopted in July 2012.

### (B) Standards Review

NASP Professional Standards were adopted in March 2010; the next Standards review process will begin in 2017.

### (C) Membership Survey

The Research Committee conducts the NASP Membership Survey every five years. Major goals of the survey are to 1) collect data on the demographic characteristics, professional practices, and employment conditions of regular members; 2) conduct analyses of the current status of the profession and of major trends over time; 3) facilitate data-based

decision-making by NASP leaders; and 4) disseminate the findings to members, researchers, and policymakers.
