OTHER PLANNING REMINDERS

(A) Strategic Plan Revisions

The Strategic Plan was adopted in July 2007 and is revised every five years.

(B) Standards Review

NASP Practice and Training Standards will be reviewed within seven years of every ten-year cycle and any revision will be adopted by the end of the ten-year cycle. Work is on target for completion of revised standards by July 1, 2010. Revisions will be implemented based on their feasibility (e.g., immediately or within a specified timeline).

(C) Membership Survey

The Research Committee conducts the NASP Membership Survey every five years. Major goals of the survey are 1) to collect data on the demographic characteristics, professional practices, and employment conditions of regular members; 2) to conduct analyses of the current status of the profession and of major trends over time; 3) to facilitate data-based decision-making by NASP leaders; and 4) to disseminate the findings to members, researchers, and policymakers. Preparations for the 2009-10 survey are underway, with the survey launch planned for June 2010.
