Major goals of the survey are to 1) collect data on the demographic characteristics, professional practices, and employment conditions of regular members; 2) conduct analyses of the current status of the profession and of major trends over time; 3) facilitate data-based decision-making by NASP leaders; and 4) disseminate the findings to members, researchers, and policymakers.
