# Mean Salaries of School Psychologists

- **Practitioners** = **\$62,513**  
(200 Day Contracts)
- **University Faculty** = **\$65,398**
- **Administration** = **\$79,536**
- **State Department** = **\$59,660**

# Contracts and Salaries: Practitioners

## ■ Contracts:

- 50.4% have contracts of 180 to 190 days
- 33.6% have contracts of 200 days or more

## ■ Mean Per Diem Salary = \$312.57

- 180 days = \$56,262
- 190 days = \$59,387
- 200 days = \$62,513
- 210 days = \$65,639
- 220 days = \$68,764

## ■ Mean Ed.S. Per Diem Salary = \$287.03

## ■ Mean Ph.D. Per Diem Salary = \$350.03
