Estimated Costs

Month in Merida: \$1900 (estimate) Includes accommodations with roommate(s) (air conditioning extra), three meals/day, Spanish instruction, & excursions.

SDSU: \$905-\$1390 (estimate) Includes course registration fee [\$1205 SDSU students or \$720 Open University students (exact fees not yet posted)], books (\$125), study abroad health insurance (\$60).

Individual Costs Vary and are NOT Included: Airfare to Cancun/Merida, Week in Quintana Roo, passport & student visa, immunizations, laundry, rain gear, lunches, souvenirs, within city transportation, gifts for host family & Spanish instructor, individual optional travel.
