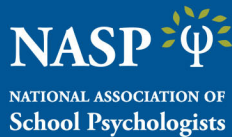


# NASP Membership Demographics

DATA AS OF APRIL 4, 2023



## Introduction and History

In 2019, the NASP Board of Directors formally requested that NASP collect member demographics to assess this data beyond the limited data that is collected through the annual and 5-year member surveys. Over time, this data is intended to present a more complete picture of the demographics of school psychology as a profession, with the eventual goal being that the diversity of NASP’s membership reflects the demographics of the students, families, and communities our members serve.

As of April 4, 2023, only 36% of current NASP members had completed this information. Because this is a small percent, this data is not intended to be interpreted or analyzed at this time, nor are we inferring that this is an accurate portrayal of the ratios of members in each demographic category. NASP plans to release biannual updates to this report each spring and fall. Please note that some percentages may not sum to 100% due to rounding errors.

## Data Collection

Members are asked to complete their Demographic Profile after renewing or joining online or on the printed membership application. Members have also been prompted via email, specifically about a week after joining or renewing, and via social media.
